WHAT WE BELIEVE THE BIBLE TEACHES ABOUT PARENTS AND CHILDREN:

Genesis 1:27-28

God created human beings in His image and made us male and female, equal yet different, so that we might bring glory to Him by displaying His goodness in marriage and family life.

Isaiah 53:6a / Romans 6:23a

Each person is born with a sinful nature that causes us to rebel by seeking our own glory and independence from God. As a result, the only thing we deserve is His just anger and judgment.
